### **Anthony Joseph Selected for Faculty of National Trial Advocacy College**

**Birmingham, Ala.** – Anthony A. Joseph, a shareholder at Maynard, Cooper & Gale, P.C., has been selected to serve as a faculty member of the National Trial Advocacy College at the University of Virginia School of Law. The National Trial Advocacy College, a partnership of Virginia Continuing Legal Education and the University of Virginia School of Law, is a program that assists attorneys in refining their trial skills. The college's faculty consists of over 50 trial lawyers, professors and judges from around the country, and as a member of the faculty, Joseph will be providing instruction on trial techniques.
